

Sugar Pots and Salt Bowls Porcelain hand building with Fleur Schell



This one day workshop will present interesting solutions to housing your sugar and spoon or cooking salt as you discover how to curl, dart and join soft slabs of textured porcelain to firmer sections. In this hands on workshop participants will learn to combine hand built, press moulded and slab constructed elements using a process of cut and paste.

Cost \$180.00 - this includes all materials, equipment and tools, lunch and light refreshments throughout the day. We would also like to welcome all participants to join the artists at SODA for a celebratory champagne sundowner at the Conclusion of the workshop.

Glazing: Participants have the option of glazing their completed pots at SODA during a three hour evening class once they have been bisque fired. Glazing will involve

dipping, pouring and wiping back using premixed glazes. The glazing date will be confirmed at the end of the making day.

Cost: \$35.00 per person and this includes a glaze demonstration, glazes, tools and a porcelain firing.
